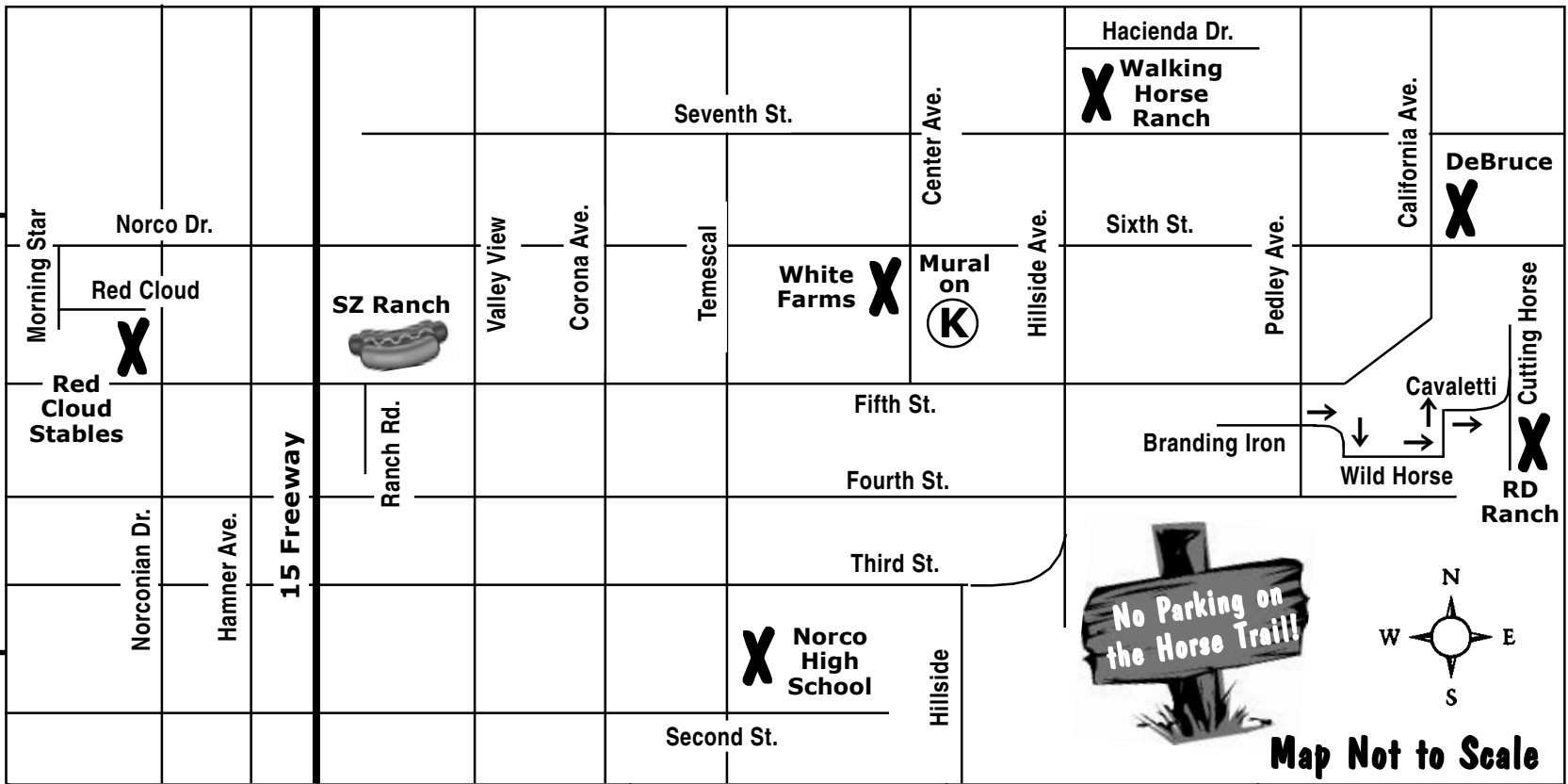
## DeBruce Minis 3985 California Ave. *Established 1975*

## Norco High School FFA 2065 Temescal Ave. *Established 1969*

The Ag Department sits on approximately 8 acres to the north side of the main campus. The department includes 4 classrooms, an agriculture mechanics shop, an office, arboretum area and the farm. Our farm includes large livestock pens, a swine unit, a small scale house, a hen house, a rabbitry and tack rooms. Horticulture is the other component of the farm. There are 2 greenhouses, a shade house, a nursery, and a canned stock area. Other areas of interest are the composting bins, soil bins and the worm beds, all in an effort to make the NHS farm a model of sustainable agriculture. The farm is home to numerous student projects and a few student run businesses, like the farm store.
